

TOURNAMENT RULES – HANDBALL – 2017

1. All matches shall be played in accordance with the rules and regulations of the (F.I.G.H.).
2. All matches will be led by referees affiliated to the F.I.G.H. A representative of the Comitato Regionale F.I.G.H. (Regional Committee) will be the Official Judge (O.J.) for all games engaged. To him/her the game reports are transmitted, for eventual decisions. The decisions are binding
3. The tournament will be played in groups in the following categories:
Male:
U17 - born on or after the 01.01.2000 - game duration 1x20'
U15 - born on or after the 01.01.2002 - game duration 1x20'

Female:
G19 - born on or after the 01.01.1998 - game duration 1x20'
G17 - born on or after the 01.01.2000 - game duration 1x20'
W - O- open age - game duration 1x20'
4. All games are played in one session without a break.
5. Each team leader must submit to the organizers a complete player list 14 with name, playing number and dates of birth of the players before 10' start of the tournament.
6. Non-identified players are not allowed to take place in that game.
7. Formula of the tournament: Group matches between the different teams in a group. According to the different rules per category
8. For all categories: if a goal is scored, the game restart by the kick off from the middle circle.
9. Maximum of players: - 14 per game including the goalkeeper(s);
10. **Every club is obliged to bring along a replacement t-shirt clearly distinguishing from the united colors. If, according to the referee, before the start of the match, the colors of the clubs are too similar, the team mentioned first in the program will be obliged to play in shirts of a different color.**
11. A penalty has a duration of 1 minute. The O.J. can decide on basis of the written report of the referee to ban a player for one or more games.
12. If a team is late for a game, without a valid reason, for a group match, all the results of this team will be declared not valid. If it concerns an intermediate match, this one will be lost with 3 – 0. The same penalty will be obtained if a team plays with players from a superior category.
13. Players of a team can only play in that team during the tournament and therefore is not allowed to play in another team.
14. When teams are level on points, the ranking will be decided by:
- Results of the mutual match - Goal difference - Most goals scored
For the U17 category the criteria for determining the best of the group are: location in the round, scored, goal difference, goals scored, draw.
15. If still no decision is reached, coin throwing will decide the winner.
16. Placing and intermediate rounds. In the event of a draw, penalty throws will be taken in accordance with the rules of the F.I.G.H.
17. Finals. In the event of a draw, penalty throws will be taken in accordance with the rules of the F.I.G.H.
18. The tournament committee has the right to alter the competition schedule, should unforeseen circumstances occur.
19. In all cases not foreseen in these tournament rules, the O.J. will decide
